Claims>Returns/Cancellations

ASA-CSSA-SSSA will replace issues lost in shipping or received damaged. Please contact our claims department (email: journals@sciencesocieties.org; fax: 608/273-2021; phone: 608/273-8080) to initiate a claim.

Please provide your member or account number, the book or magazine title, year/volume, issue, and indicate whether it is missing or damaged in shipment. **Claims will be replaced one time only.**

Missing or Damaged Issue Claim

Claims for magazine issues or books not received or received damaged should be made within 6 months of the date of publication, or upon receipt of the next issue, whichever is sooner. **Claims will be shipped once.** Issues that are missing after 6 months of publication or for the second time can be purchased at the back issue rate.

Year End CD Returns

CD returns are only accepted if they are damaged or defective. Please notify the claims department immediately upon receipt of a damaged or defective CD to receive a replacement. Note the type of damage or defect. We will accept returns received during the first 60 days after shipping for U.S. orders, or 90 days after shipping for international orders.

Subscription Cancellation

A cancellation request received before the second issue is published for any reason will be issued a full refund. A cancellation request received after the second issue has been published is not refundable.

Subscription Changes

A change in a subscription can be made in the media type with a lateral change or an upgrade. For example, single journal subscription to the Digital Library.

Electronic Journals

Use of the Journal(s)

Authorized users may download, search, and save materials for their own use. Materials from the Journal(s) may not be used to recompile, manipulate, or to prepare derivative uses or publish in another format without prior permission from the Societies.

Inter-Library Loans (Authorized for Institutional Subscribers Only)

Institutions may use hard or electronic copies derived directly or indirectly from the electronic edition of the Journal(s) for making inter-library loans. Copies must be in compliance with Section 108 of the Copyright Act of the U.S. and with guidelines developed by the National Commission on New Technological Uses of Copyrighted Works (CONTU Guidelines) (see U.S. Copyright Office Circular 21).

Multi-Campus or Consortium Access

A conventional (non-Digital Library) subscription does not permit the use of the Journal(s) on multiple campuses, multi-site industrial use, or regional consortiums with more than one site. Use of the Digital Library

Except as provided in Permitted Uses herein, Licensee, its Authorized Users and Other Users agree not to forward, transfer, sell, rent, or otherwise knowingly distribute or provide access to the ACSESS Products or any portions thereof, to any third party. Individual articles, individual book chapters, proceedings, or other individual items from the ACSESS Products and other information obtained under this Agreement may not be used for fee-for-service purposes such as document delivery, except under a separately negotiated transactional agreement. Under no circumstances are the following actions permitted:

Post Cancellation Rights and Access

Access Rights for Cancelled Subscribers to ACSESS Electronic Editions
